The Furies (Also Known as the Erinyes, the Eumenides, or the Dirae)


The Sisterhood of Furies serves as the arcane equivalent of mortal law enforcement and is responsible for investigating, prosecuting, and meting out justice against arcane beings who commit crimes. Historically, the Sisterhood has conducted its duties as an independent entity answering only to the gods and goddesses to whom the Furies are oathbound.

In the decades since the Peace Accord between mortals and arcanes, however, many Furies have become liaisons to mortal law enforcement branches across the United States. One Fury has actually become a full-fledged member of our own Boston Police Department: Chief Magical Investigator, Marissa

Holloway. A member of the Tisiphone class of the Sisterhood of Furies, Chief Holloway is well-known for her dedicated pursuit of justice for both mortal and arcane victims of arcanecommitted crimes.

Furies can be easily recognized by the red leather uniforms they wear along with the magical serpent tattoos they bear upon each arm. These serpents, or Amphisbaena, change into real-life snakes when the Furies need assistance from their magical familiars. Furies can shape-shift into any form they choose, making them the only surviving race of arcanes who can do so.

Furies are divided into three separate branches, or classes.

Fury Classes: Alecto, Megaera, and Tisiphone

Alecto—the Unceasing—blue Amphisbaena.

This class primarily investigates assaults, batteries, physical child abuse crimes, and most cold cases.

Megaera—the Jealous One—green Amphisbaena.

This class investigates kidnappings, stalkings, sexual abuse crimes, and murders committed in the heat of passion. Tisiphone—Avenging Murder—red Amphisbaena.

This class is responsible first and foremost for investigating murders, although certain homicides may be passed on to other classes.
